Lions Clubs International Kindness Matters Service Award Rules

To qualify for the Kindness Matters Service Award (KMSA) your club must meet the following eligibility and criteria:

Eligibility

- Are in active status
- ▶ Reported their project(s) in MyLion® or regional reporting system
- Did not receive the award within the last three fiscal years

Criteria

- Addresses needs within Lions International and LCIF's causes: diabetes, environment, vision, childhood cancer, hunger, disaster relief, youth, humanitarian
- Demonstrates creativity and innovation
- Achieves impact of scale and long-term sustainability
- Uses Lions International's values to shape positive experiences and create engagement and connection with the Lions brand (this is also known as "elevating the Lions brand")

Deadlines

All nominations must be completed and electronically submitted to Lions International by October 31 to the serviceactivities@lionsclubs.org email. Any nominations submitted beyond October 31 will be disqualified.

The following deadlines are guiding deadlines to help the nomination process at the local level.

- July 1 to October 31: Nominations are open.
- August 15: Deadline for club service chairpersons and Leo club presidents to electronically send one nomination to the district global service team (D GST) coordinator.
- **September 15**: Deadline for D GST coordinator to electronically send one nomination to the multiple district global service team (MD GST) coordinator.
- > October 31: Deadline for MD GST coordinator to send one Lions and/or one Leo nomination to Lions International.





NOMINATION FORM RULES

- The Service project description answers must be no longer than 200 words per question and must be submitted as a supplemental document typewritten in black ink and double spaced.
- The remaining sections of the nomination form must be typewritten in black ink.
- ▶ Endorsement signatures can be typewritten in black ink.
- Each nomination form must be submitted with all the sections complete with all appropriate endorsements included. Nomination forms submitted without completed information and/or the proper endorsements will be disqualified.
- Multiple districts may submit one Lions club and one Leo club nomination per year.
- Lions club and Leo club nominations should be submitted separately.
- A minimum of three of the 30 awards will be awarded to Leo clubs.
